The SRS fee will be **\$90 per participating student**, offering families excellent value and access to a range of high-quality online learning programs, The Resilience Project Journal, and art and craft supplies.

Below is an overview of the key programs included and the benefits they provide to our students:

**Seesaw:**

Seesaw for Schools is an innovative digital platform designed to engage students in learning and streamline communication between teachers, students, and parents. It provides a comprehensive set of tools that help educators manage their curriculum, assess progress, and provide personalised feedback.

**Key Features:**

- 1. Interactive Lessons:** With Seesaw, teachers can create multimedia lessons and interactive activities to engage students in learning and helps personalise learning to cater to different learning styles.
- 2. Student Portfolios:** Each student has their own digital portfolio where they can store assignments and evidence of their work. This allows teachers to track individual progress easily and offer personalised feedback

**3P Learning:**

The **3Essentials Package** includes Reading, Writing, and Maths through platforms such as **Mathletics, Mathseeds, Reading Eggs, Reading Eggspress, Fast Phonics, The Library, Mathseeds Prime, and Writing Legends**, these are all accessible via a single login.

This integrated solution supports students to close learning gaps while providing extension opportunities for those ready to be challenged.
